1 Program Purpose

- KMOU was selected as the host university to carry out **a government-funded project, “Global Invitation Program in the field of Maritime and Ocean Sciences”**
- This program is designed to provide international students with opportunities to study in the field of maritime and ocean science at KMOU at the level of undergraduate.
- This program will enhance international education exchange and deepen mutual friendship between Korea and participating countries.

2 Program Overview

- **Study Period : Spring 2021(One semester)**
 - **From the beginning of March to the Middle of June (15 weeks)**
 - ※ *According to the Korean government policy to prevent COVID-19 spread, the entry date will be the middle of February 2021 (Quarantine Period : 14 days)*
- **Host : National Korea Maritime & Ocean University (KMOU)**
- **Supported by :**
Ministry of Oceans and Fisheries (Korea) and Gyeongsangbuk-do (Korean local government)
- **Program includes :**
 - Regular academic courses, Team projects with graduate school mentors, Korean language & culture, Field trips to Korean research institutions (Maritime & Ocean), Visit to historical sites
 - Regular academic courses are 3 or 4 credit courses by each field :
 - ① **Maritime Science AND** ② **Ocean Science**
 - KMOU will divide two groups with two categories, ① **AND** ②
- **Official Transcript :** After a semester, it will be issued to participants who fully complete.
- **Number of students to be selected : Total 25 students**
 - ① **Maritime Science : 13 students** ② **Ocean Science : 12 students**
 - ※ **Please note that KMOU has a final authority to select successful candidates.**
- **Language to be used : English**

3 Program Qualification

★ Qualification MUST be satisfied the following ①, ②, ③, ④, ⑤ AND ⑥

- ① Applicants must be **undergraduate students** at their home universities.
- ② Applicants must currently be enrolled **at least 4th semester** in their home universities
(=have completed at least 3rd semester before they apply)
- ③ Applicants' **major** should be related to **① maritime science OR ② ocean science.**
- ④ Applicants must fulfill the following GPA requirement :
GPA 3.0/4.5 (equivalent to 2.8/4.3, 2.5/4.0) **OR** percentile rank 70
- ⑤ Fluent level of English language is as follows:
① TOEFL 530 (CBT 197, iBT 71), ② IELTS 5.5 **OR** ③ TOEIC 600
- ⑥ Applicants must have sound mind and good health during their study.

5 Documnet Submission

- Applicants **MUST** submit all required documents **to their home university's coordinators**.
 - ※ Applicants **should not send** documents **directly to KMOU**.
- All documents should be submitted in original or verified as an official copy and should be in English. If the documents are not in English, applicants must have them translated in English and certified & sealed by the authorized body.
 - ※ **For 2021 academic year, partner universities can send required documents by email to KMOU due to the COVID-19 spread.**

6 Program Benefits(Expenses)

- **KMOU tuition fee** for Spring 2021 will be **waived**.
 - ※ During study at KMOU, final candidates must register and pay their tuition fee to their home universities.
- **KMOU will support candidates' round-trip airfares, dormitory fees (including regular meals) and other program fees during this program period.**
- Final candidates should be responsible for their daily living expenses in Korea and expenses of buying overseas travel insurance (illness, injury and indemnity)
