2025 tuition fees and costs

Tuition (fee-paying Study Abroad program)

AU\$11,000* per semester for 4 x 12.5% units. AU\$8,250* per semester for 3 x 12.5% units.

Mandatory Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC)

AU\$488 for 1 semester; AU\$929.75 for full year.

Entry requirements

GPA Requirement

GPA 2.5 on a scale of 4.0 or equivalent.

Special circumstances

Lower GPA applications will be considered upon recommendation from the home institution.

Postgraduate student acceptance

Postgraduates may undertake an exchange by coursework only. Applications are assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Minimum course requirements for full-time load

A full-time enrolment is 4 x 12.5% units per semester. Some student visas (subclass 500) allow for enrolment in a reduced load of 3 x 12.5% units (minimum).

Students require one of the following English

(Undergraduate)

English Language Requirements

language results:

- · IELTS (Academic): 6.0, no band below 5.5
- · TOEFL (iBT): 72 (no skill below: Reading 10; Listening 9; Speaking 16; Writing 19)
- · PTE (Academic): 50 with no score lower than 42
- UTASAccess English: Overall 60% (no individual score less than 55%)
- · Cambridge CAE B Grade.

Students from the following countries can meet the English Proficiency requirement with a letter of approval from their home university: Austria, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Netherlands, Norway, and Sweden.



Additional accommodation costs

All fees must be paid two weeks in advance via direct debit from an Australian Bank account, or, upfront prior to the beginning of each semester.

A non-refundable Acceptance Fee of AU\$150 is payable upon acceptance of an offer for accommodation.

A security deposit of AU\$500 is also payable on acceptance of an offer of accommodation.

Is accommodation guaranteed?

Accommodation on campus isn't guaranteed, so we recommend applying as early as possible to secure your spot. If you're not successful, our Accommodation Services Team is here to support you in finding other great options.

To help you budget, the average cost of living per semester (including things like rent, food, entertainment and books) is around AU\$10,000.
